

YOUTH POLICY FAQs

Melbourne

Can a youth (U18 patron) attend Melbourne Knotfest unaccompanied?

No all youth ticket holders attending the event must be accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or responsible adult and each person attending must have their own valid ticket.

Youth ticket holders without a parent, legal guardian or responsible adult will be refused entry to the event.

What is the definition of a parent, legal guardian or responsible adult?

The definition of a **responsible adult** is:

- A person who is of or over the age of 18 years and is:
- the minor's parent, step-parent, guardian, grandparent, or
- the minor's spouse who is above the age of 18, or
- a person who is over 18 and acting in place of a parent or guardian and who could reasonably be expected to exercise responsible supervision of the minor.

How can register my emergency contact information?

This can be done at the event at anyone of the two youth processing points near either entry point at the Melbourne event. Just simply make your way over the youth processing tent and provide your emergency contact information which will be applied to the youth wristband.

Patrons arriving via vehicle will park their vehicles in the VRC VIP carpark on Leonard Crescent and then make the short walk to the event entry point within the members carpark, patron Entry gate 1. The Youth Processing tent is located on the left hand side of the entry gate.

Patrons arriving via Metro Train will arrive at the internal Flemington Racecourse Rail Station and then also make the short walk to the member carpark patron Entry Gate 1. The Youth Processing tent is located on the left hand side of the entry gate.

Patrons arriving via Ride share, Taxi tram, bus or on foot entering the site via Epsom Road gates will face a short walk to the event entry point and Entry Gate 2. The Youth Processing tent is located on the left hand side of the entry gate.

My youth ticket emergency contact information has changed is this a problem?

No this is not a problem simply visit the youth processing tent and provide your updated emergency contact details and they will be applied to the youth wristband.

What do I need to provide at the youth processing point?

The parent, legal guardian or responsible adult must present with their accompanied youth where the:

Youth ticket will be scanned.

Emergency contact information supplied and applied to wristband.

Youth wristband applied to youth patron.

The parent, legal guardian or responsible adult then accompanies the youth through the appropriate lane at the entry gate where the adult will be processed.

Once inside the event can a youth (U18) separate from their parent, legal guardian or responsible adult?

No, all youth ticket holders attending the event must remain accompanied by their parent, legal guardian or responsible adult throughout the duration of the event.

What do I do, within the event site If I am to become separated from my parent, legal guardian or responsible?

Consult RSA Crowd controllers or event staff who will escort you to the Found Youth tent adjacent to Entry gate 1.

Trained staff at the Found Youth tent with "working with children" certification will make efforts to reunite you with your parent, legal guardian or responsible adult.
